THE MISSION of South Cumberland Community Fund is to improve the quality of life across the Plateau by increasing philanthropic giving and providing community leadership to:

- Build on the strength of the area's people, communities and natural setting
- Enhance community capacity and collaboration
- Support innovative ways to solve community problems

SCCF IS PLEASED TO share our 2018 Report on Philanthropy that highlights how we have partnered with organizations across the Plateau since 2012 to impact the health and quality of life of residents young and old. The World Health Organization defines health as "a state of complete physical, mental, and social well-being, and not merely the absence of disease." This is why our partnership with Beersheba Springs Medical Clinic, the Grundy County Health Council, Mountain Goat Trail Alliance, local schools and community organizations, and the University of the South, to name a few, has been so important to our collective work on the Plateau.

Thanks to you and your support we have been able to expand our partnerships with local organizations and leaders who are eager to create meaningful change. Through our collaborations with the Mountain Goat Trail we are connecting communities across the Plateau while providing an opportunity for all residents to enjoy the outdoors and reap the physical and mental health benefits. Through our grants program and collaboration with the University of the South in its sponsorship of the AmeriCorps VISTA and Bonner and Canale student leader programs, area schools have created gardens, after-school health education and activity programs, and walking trails. This collaboration has also expanded the reach of Activ8 Grundy in partnership with the Grundy County Health Council by providing Walk with the Mayor events, Run Club, and a diabetes prevention program, all of which culminated in a Governor's Healthier TN Communities designation for Grundy County. Through the VISTA program, we are supporting the crucial work of the Grundy Safe Communities Coalition Opioid Abuse Prevention Program, with more

than 700 elementary and middle school students participating in the Coalition's anti-drug programming.

Grants to Folks at Home have provided programs for elders to support healthy aging through the Boost Your Brain Memory Program and the Walk with Ease movement and strengthening program. Falls are one of the greatest threats to those who are aging, and the Walk with Ease program provides techniques for safe walking, while improving flexibility, stamina, and strength.

This report features the Beersheba Springs Medical Clinic and the new dental suite they are developing. As we know, oral health is important to one's overall health. According to the Mayo Clinic, gum disease appears to be more frequent and severe among diabetes patients, which is especially significant given the incidence of a higher rate of diabetes on the Plateau. This project is another example of organizations coming together to leverage funds to provide access to crucial services on the Plateau, and SCCF is proud to provide support to make this needed dental service available. To borrow a familiar phrase, it truly does take a village - and we have a good one.

We remain inspired by the incredible people and organizations who have joined together to make the Plateau a place of hope and prosperity. We thank you for your continued trust in supporting our efforts and we look forward to a healthy and productive 2019!

First Free Dental Clinic on the Plateau

Dr. Garrett Adams, founder of Beersheba Springs Medical Clinic, believes many Americans have fallen victim to a health system they cannot afford. As he explains, patients come to the Clinic who have never received medical attention in their lives, a fact supported by his account of providing treatment for a man in his 50s who had never had a physical examination. “The need is desperate,” Adams says. “We can fill that need, but we need help.” South Cumberland Community Fund is proud to collaborate with Beersheba Springs Medical Clinic in this effort to improve lives across the Mountain, and beyond.

Since the Clinic opened, Dr. Adams has been struck by the incidence of tooth abscess in patients. This trend led him to explore the possibility of adding dental care to the Clinic’s portfolio. In spring of 2018 SCCF awarded a \$9,864 grant to fund the

cost of a dental chair and compressor to equip the first dental suite to offer services at no charge on the Plateau. The dental clinic is expected to open in April or May of 2019.

Dr. Bruce Baird, a retired dentist who makes his home on the Plateau, will provide the dental care for this new endeavour. Initially, the focus will be on tooth extraction; the hope is to find other qualified medical personnel to volunteer at the Clinic to enable the facility to offer additional dental services for its patients.

SCCF’s partnership with Beersheba Springs Medical Clinic and other health-related organizations on the Mountain has provided a variety of opportunities for SCCF to support initiatives that improve the lives of area residents. These improvements serve as incentives for future generations to exercise, eat healthy foods, and be part of a community dedicated to well-being for all.

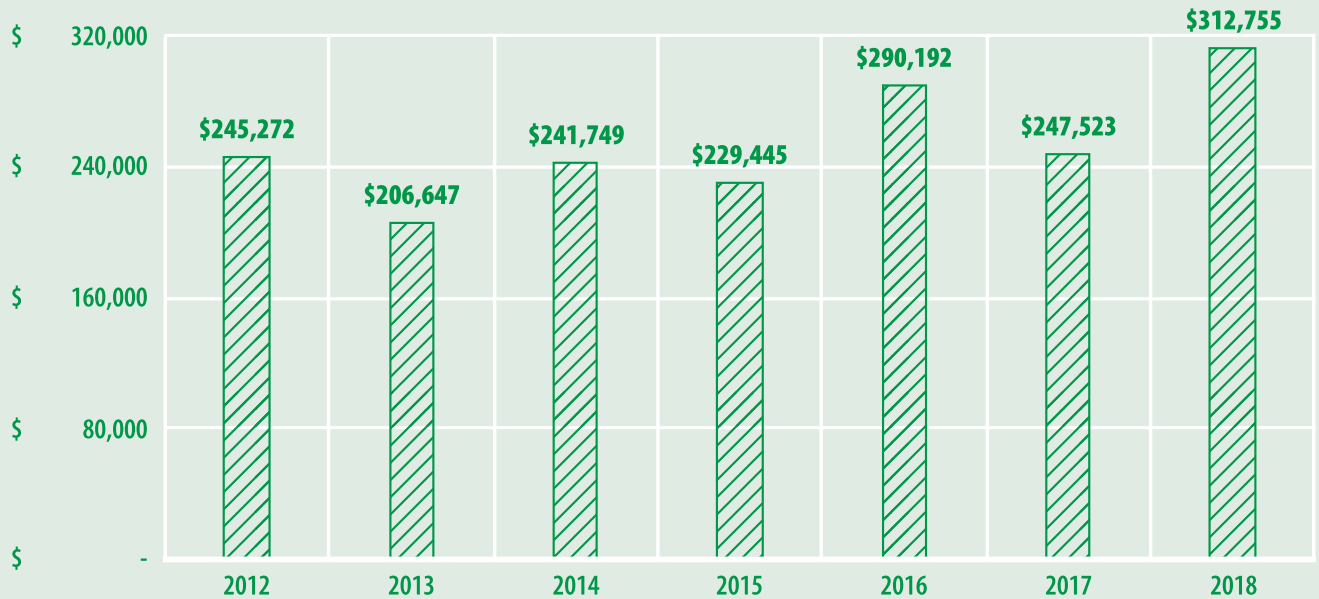

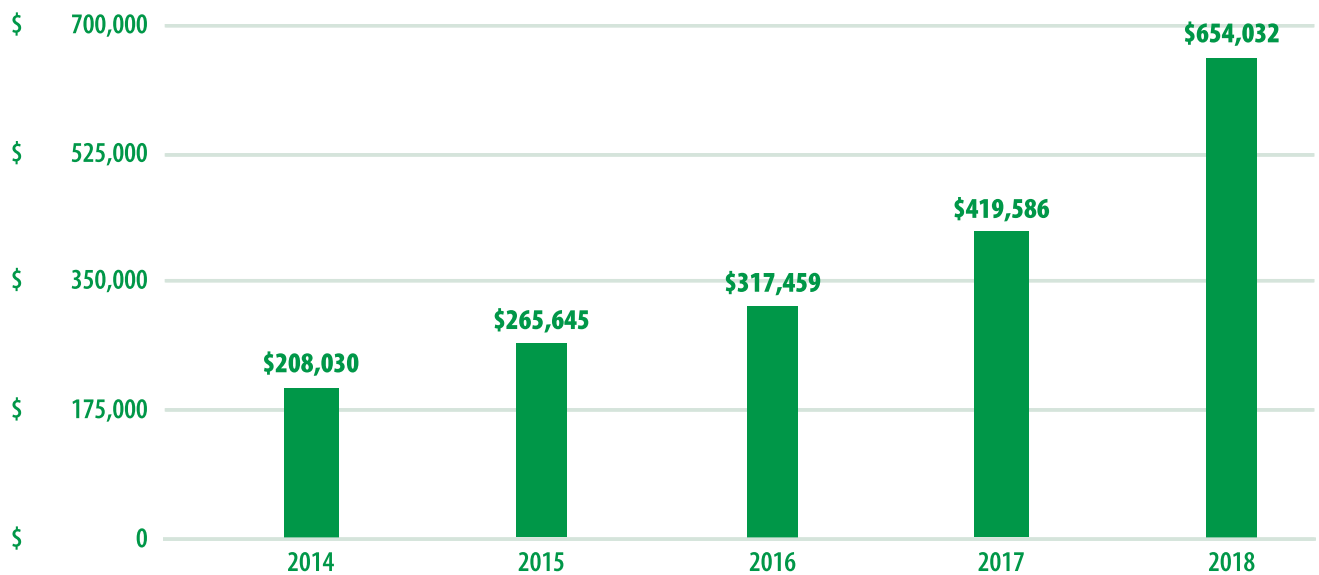

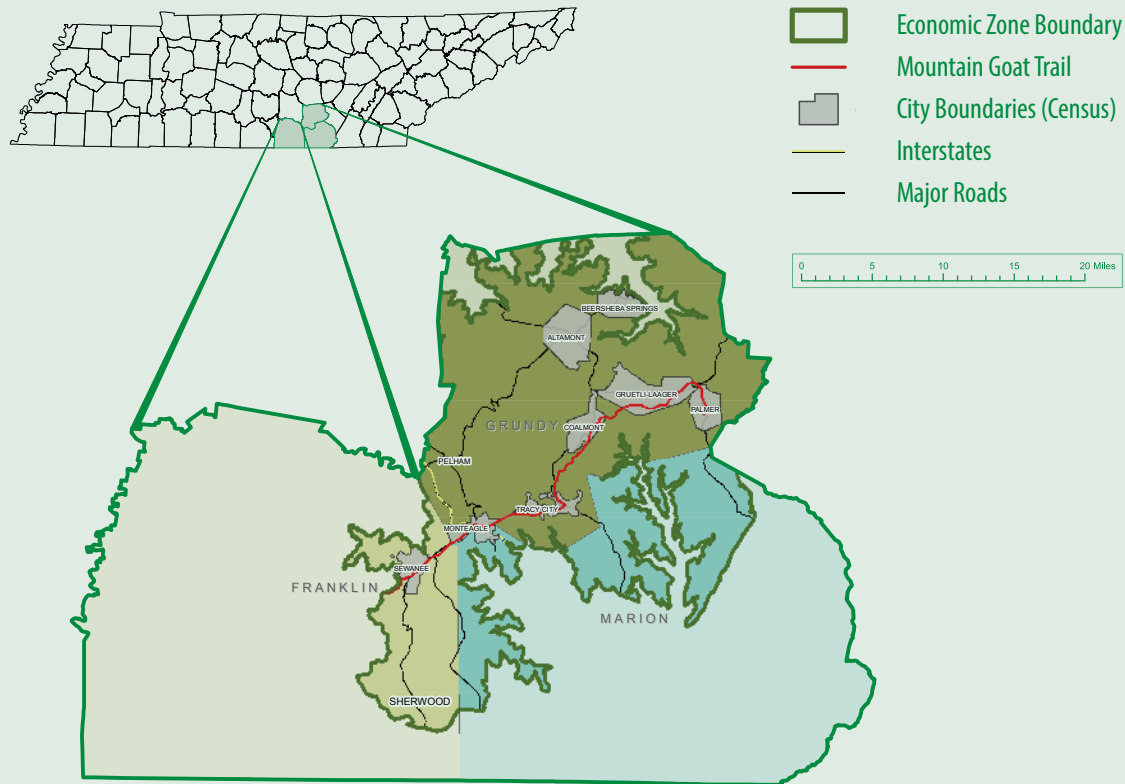
