

# YOUTH/EDUCATION

## **Discover Together**

This new local initiative is aimed at creating innovative programs in support of developing strong children and families. Our grant supported the Family Co-op Project, providing a gathering place for pre-school children and their families for recreation, mutual support, and participation in literacy-oriented learning activities. The project was implemented with support from Scholastic press and the Yale Child Study Center, which will receive and administer the grant.

# **HEALTH/WELLNESS**

## **Grundy County Health Council**

The Health Council seeks to improve the health of local residents and decrease health disparities in the community. A current focus of the Council is preventing and reversing obesity and diabetes through educational programs and physical activities. A Community Fund grant provided equipment to support the monitoring of weight, blood pressure, and blood glucose in the Reversing Diabetes program.





# **CULTURE/RECREATION**

### **Grundy Area Arts Council**

The GAAC has worked for two decades to foster cultural activities in the region, creating opportunities for local arts and artists, and serving audiences with limited access to the arts. Using a Community Fund grant and other resources, the GAAC developed a Student Theater Project, through which local elementary school students learned theater techniques and performed "The Other Side of the Mountain," an adaptation of a story written by local author May Justus.
